Abstract

In my research study after stastical analysis and the proper follow ups of all 90 cases the effects of three indicated medicines i.e. Ferrum Picricum, Methylene Blue, Salicylic Acid gives almost equal effects on the patients suffering from seropositive RA which satisfies my research hypothesis. In my study mean age of the Rheumatoid Arthritis patient was 41.11 ± 9.67 Yrs (Mean \pm SD), the maximum number of cases from age group 40-50 years (35.56%). Rheumatoid Arthritis patient was common in female patient (n=51, 56.67%) than the male patients (n=39, 43.33%) during my study. It shows that - Rheumatoid Arthritis is more common in female patients. In my study Rheumatoid Arthritis patient's prevalence is equal in rural area (n=45, 50%) and urban area (n=45, 50%). Paired t-test was used for analysing the pre and post treatment (after 6 months) scores individually for each medicinal group. After applying the paired t-test show that the changes in the symptoms of Rheumatoid Arthritis for all three medicines is highly significant that means result shows lowering the intensity and severity of symptoms related to Rheumatoid Arthritis by each medicine in aspect of joint involved, RF, CRP, ACPA, ESR. Ferrum Picricum, Methylene Blue and Salicylic Acid drugs are effective in cases of Rheumatoid Arthritis. After using the paired Ttest it showed that the null hypothesis is rejected and alternative or research hypothesis is It means Homoeopathic medicines as mentioned in clinical rubric indicated in approved. Clarke's clinical repertory are effective in management of Rheumatoid Arthritis.

In 1859 The name "Rheumatoid Arthritis" itself was invented bv British Rheumatologist Dr Alfred Baring Garrod. CONCLUSION

After treatment of over all cases the outcome result of 90 cases - is 40 cases were improved, 36 cases were recovered and 14 cases were in "not improved" category (as per mentioned in methodology).as individual we go for result of each medicine - in ferrum pic treated cases the result was - 14 cases were improved, 11 cases were recovered and 5 cases were in " not improved" category. 11 cases were improved, 15 cases were recovered and 4 cases were in "not improved" category when cases treated by drug methylene blue. And in cases of drug salicylicylic acid 15 cases were improved,

10 were recovered and 5 cases was not improved.

Three Homoeopathic drugs mentioned in Clarkes Repertory under clinical rubric Rheumatoid Arthritis were found to reduce joint involvement in 90 patients with RA; t value=19.0547, P<.001 (for ferrum pic; n=30, paired t value = 8.86, for methylene blue; n=30, paired t value = 13.87, for salicylic acid;n=30, t=15.33: Ρ < 0.001). The 2010 ACR/EULAR Diagnostic score reduced in all 90 patients t=22.38063; P < 0.001 (30 patients for ferrum pic t = 11.32, 30patients for methylene blue t = 14.05,30patients for salicylic acid t= 13.05; P < 0.001). Mean ESR improved to 18.51 from 29.11 (t = 20.10144, P < 0.05). Out of 90, 31 (34.44%) patients were found to be Sero-negative after given three Homoeopathic drug-Ferrum Picricum, Methylene Blue And Salicylic Acid. Psora- Sycosis is the dominant miasm mostly found among 90 Rheumatic Arthritis patients.
